This scholarship was formed to honor the outstanding service of Mrs. Darlene Francavitch, RN. A 1954 alumna of MVTHS, Mrs. Fran, as she is affectionately known, attended the St. John's School of Nursing in Springfield, graduating in 1957. She worked for a year on the urology floor at St. John's, then returned to MV to work for Dr. Anslinger. In 1968, the MV Area Vocational Center was in its infancy, and she was selected to be the first teacher in the new health service aide program. The program took off, and the core skills program was quickly added. Mrs. Fran taught in the AVC until her retirement in 1991, in addition to being chair of the health department. She continues to work as a substitute school nurse and assists in the health science department as well.

Mrs. Francavitch received both her Bachelor's and Master's Degrees from Southern Illinois University-Carbondale. She is married to John Francavitch and has three children, and is active in her church.

We thank Mrs. Fran for her shining example and strive to continue her tradition of providing compassionate and excellent education in health science.
