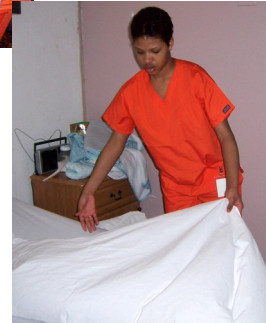


HOSA

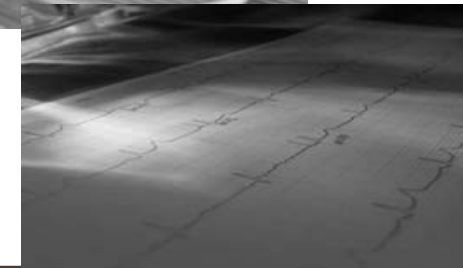
