

Mt. Vernon FFA Chapter Awards at 2008 State FFA Convention

The Mt. Vernon Township High School Agriculture Department and the Mt. Vernon FFA were honored at the 80th Illinois State FFA Convention as 9th place in Illinois out of a total of 311 FFA Chapters across the state.

The Mt. Vernon High School Agriculture Program took home many top honors from the 80th Annual Illinois Association State FFA Convention in Springfield on June 10-12, 2008. The Mt. Vernon FFA also toured Lincoln's Library, and other President Lincoln historical sites. They had 13 members present, with two advisors and four guests.

The Mt. Vernon FFA is a student organization set up by the United States Education Department in Washington, D.C. The FFA is an integral part of the high school agriculture department. The Mt. Vernon FFA Chapter has put together over 280 activities outside the classroom the past calendar year, with 189 students from Mt. Vernon Township High School to complement all the skills that the students learn in the classroom. All of this hard work and dedication by the students and teachers helped the Mt. Vernon FFA Chapter to land one of the top agriculture programs in the State.

The Mt. Vernon FFA Chapter received the following awards at the 80th Annual State FFA Convention:

Triple Gold FFA Chapter Award - Forty-four of a total of 348 high schools in Illinois received this award.

National Chapter Award - The Mt. Vernon FFA Chapter is among 22 other FFA Chapters that will advance to the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis, Ind. in October, 2008 as a National Finalist Chapter.

Anthony and Timothy will receive their degrees at the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis in October 2008.

State FFA Officer Candidate - Anthony Graham was selected as a Top Ten State FFA Officer Candidate. Anthony went through a rigorous interview process that consisted of a two prepared speeches, an extemporaneous speech, an interview, take two tests, participate in a letter writing exercise, and participate in a group activity with nine other candidates. Anthony gave five speeches onstage at convention in front of the 3,000 members, advisors, and guests present.

State FFA Talent - Lamanda Bean sang in front of the 3,000 members, guests, and parents. She will have a chance to advance to the National FFA Convention in October, 2008.
