



Did You Know.....

- ➔ The LRC has a physical collection of approximately 24,000 books, 163 magazine subscriptions, 21 newspaper subscriptions, 1,989 videotapes, 344 DVDs, 122 music CD's, and 15 audio books.
- ➔ The LRC has a viewing/listening room that students can use to watch videos/DVDs as a group or individually. Two computers are available for interactive DVD telecourses and internet classes.
- ➔ Full-time and part-time instructors can request that books, videos and electronic resources be added to the Library's collection by using the "Materials Request Form" @ <http://www.rlc.edu/lrc/lrcmaterialform.php>
- ➔ The Reference Librarian, Beth Mandrell, provides workshops to teach students how to use electronic and print information resources collected by the LRC. Workshops customized for your students can be scheduled for day and evening classes.
- ➔ The LRC has a new wireless lab (16 computers) that your class can use for group research sessions. Contact Beth Mandrell (x1276) to reserve the room for your class.
- ➔ Library users can place holds online for print materials from the RLC collection or from other participating libraries.
- ➔ The audio-visual collection is now part of the automated catalog. You can search (online) for A.V. materials by subject or title.
- ➔ The Electronic Library provides access to 61 online information resources. (A list of online resources is printed on the back of this page.) The E-library link is found on the RLC website @ <http://www.rlc.edu/lrc/el.php>
- ➔ All current RLC employees can access the Electronic Library off-campus. Contact Beth Mandrell (x1276) to set up an account. (Students have access to the Electronic Library off-campus by setting up their own account through online student records. This is the same account students use to access grades.)
- ➔ Library users can get help from a librarian online, 24 hours a day, by using Ask Away @ <http://www.rlc.edu/lrc/askaquestion.php>
- ➔ Serial Solutions is an Electronic Library resource that helps you locate a specific journal without searching through individual databases. The Electronic Library is @ <http://www.rlc.edu/lrc/el.php>
